In Piece of Work's Edinburgh Fringe debut, Script in Hand, Paul Warriner (Coronation Street, Shameless), plays Toby Williams, an actor who finds the part of a lifetime, only to lose it by the second rehearsal. Overcome with injustice and an obsession with German typographer Paul Renner, the man he was to play, Toby sets about creating his own one-man show. With this show, Toby hopes to do Renner's life and work justice, while attacking those who have, in his opinion, set about to undermine it. But can this version of history remain unchallenged?

Under the guise of a script in hand reading, every audience member given a copy of the play, **Script in Hand** tells the story of an actor and the part he cannot have.

For this project, Piece of Work have collaborated with animator **Andy Cooper**, whose previous work includes 'As the World Tipped' (Wired Aerial Theatre), and composer **Anton Hunter**, a founder member of the 14 piece Beats & Pieces Big Band who won the European Young Jazz Award, 2011.

Script in Hand is written and directed by Sean Gregory, a graduate of the UEA Creative Writing MA and co-founder of Piece of Work. Sean's first play 'Donal Fleet' was performed at Hampstead Theatre in 2009. The production is produced by company members Rosie Scott & Jo Smart; technical direction by Joel Clements.

Piece of Work create multi-disciplinary work, staged in unconventional theatre spaces. This is the second production by the company, the first, Reeling, played to sell-out audiences at the 2010 24:7 Theatre Festival, Manchester.
